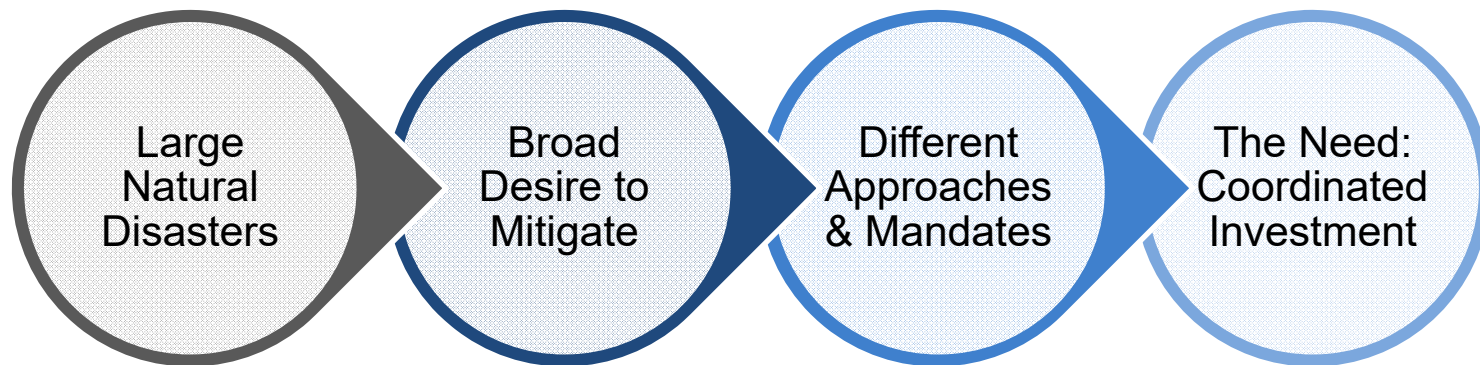

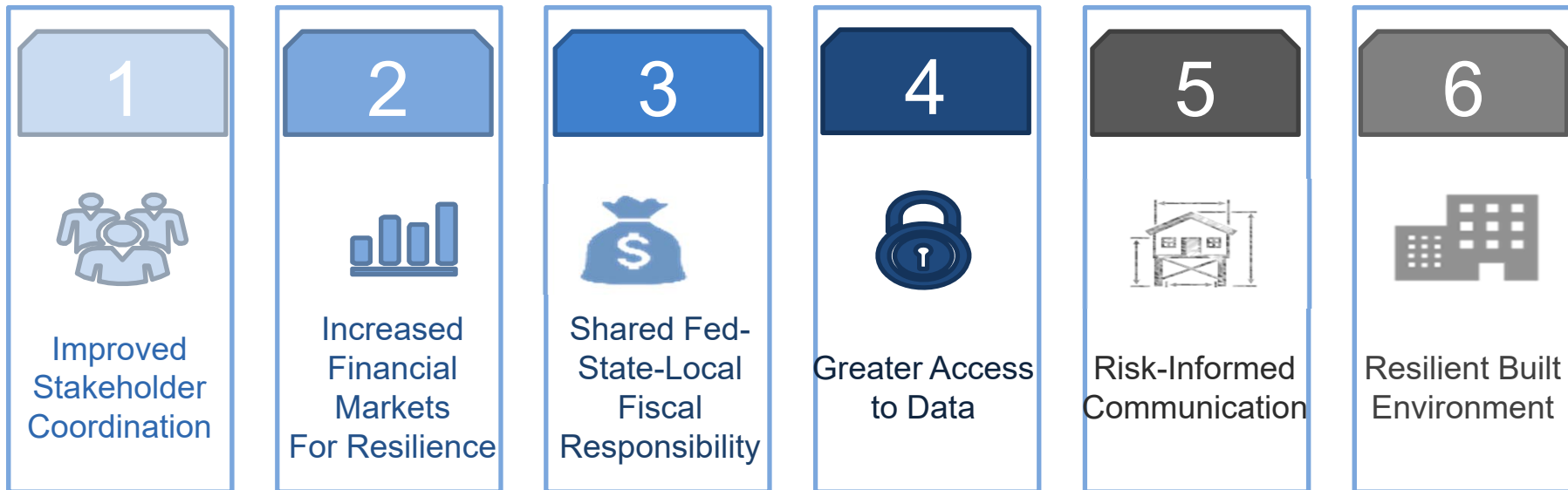


The MitFLG should establish an investment strategy to identify, prioritize, and implement federal investments in disaster resilience.
