



Place fuel tank 30 feet away

Why

 Protects the home from potential explosions due to fuel tank ignition.

How

- Place fuel storage tanks 30 feet from the home, away from downhill slopes, and enclose them behind a non-combustible masonry wall.
- If possible, bury pressurized storage fuel tank vessels underground.
- Consult an experienced, licensed contractor for assistance.

How to Identify

Measure the distance between the home and the fuel tank to ensure they are at least 30 feet apart. Keep the area around the tank free of vegetation and flammable materials.
