



Install non-combustible (metal) leaf guards over gutters

Why

Reduces the chance of embers igniting leaves, pine needles, sticks, or other debris trapped in the gutters.

How

 Use gutters and downspouts constructed of noncombustible materials like galvanized steel, copper, or aluminum.

- Install non-combustible leaf guards over gutters, using either metal mesh screens or metal hoods.
- Leaf guards may not prevent all debris from accumulating, so regularly remove any debris resting on top and verify that the leaf guard is not dislodged.
- or an experienced, licensed contractor for assistance.

How to Identify

Check the gutters to determine if they are metal and if they have leaf guards that prevent debris buildup. The leaf guards should be made of metal mesh or have a solid cover that blocks leaves and pine needles.
